DEFINITIONS

Construction Waste: Lumber and other building material; Crating and packing material.

Demolition Waste: Material from a complete or partial destruction of a man-made structure; Clearing any site for land improvement or cleanup.

Yard Debris: Grass clippings; Tree leaves and needles; Small branches; Bush and garden clippings.

Domestic Waste: Paper, cardboard, clothing.

Slash Burning: The burning of "Logging Debris" and is limited to burning on forestlands for forest management only and is usually managed by ODF (Oregon Department of Forestry). It is NOT the clearing of land for any other purpose.

Agricultural Waste: Material generated by an agricultural operation that uses land for the purpose of obtaining a profit by raising, harvesting and selling crops or animals. Ag burning is NOT backyard or slash burning and is regulated solely by the Department of Agriculture.

Commercial Waste: DEQ regulations prohibit the open burning of commercial waste in the Willamette Valley. Waste from offices, warehouses, restaurants, mobile home parks, domestic waste that has been removed from the property of origin, waste from dwellings that contain four or more units.
